

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the **EMERGENCY REPAIR OF GASKIN ROAD AND SLOPE STABILIZATION** for the Town of Clay will be received by the Town Clerk at Town Hall, 4401 Route 31, Clay, NY 13041, until **11:00 a.m. local time, on Friday February 24, 2023**, and then at said time publicly opened and read aloud.

The work includes providing all labor, materials, machinery, tools, equipment and other means of construction necessary and incidental to the completion of the work shown on the plans and described in these specifications including, but not necessarily limited to the following: Reconstruction of approximately 875 linear feet of Gaskin Road beginning at the NYS Route 31 intersection. Work includes full depth asphalt pavement reconstruction, single course mill and overlay, closed drainage, replacement of guiderail, traffic signs, pavement markings, and installation of steel sheet pile wall for slope stabilization.

The Town of Clay shall not be held responsible for the completeness or accuracy of any bid documents received by a Contractor that were not directly issued to that Contractor by C&S Engineers, Inc.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids.


Each bidder must deposit with their bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and prevailing wage rates to be paid under the contract.

The Owner is exempt from the payment of sales and compensating use taxes of the State of New York and of cities and counties on all materials, equipment and supplies sold to the Owner pursuant to this Contract. Also exempt from such taxes are purchases by the Contractor and their Subcontractors of materials, equipment, and supplies to be sold to the Owner pursuant to this Contract, including tangible personal property to be incorporated in any structure, building, or other real property forming part of the Project. These taxes are not to be included in the Bid.

No bidder may withdraw their bid within 45 days after the actual date of opening thereof.
