REGULAR MEETING:

Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2022 amending Chapter 230, entitled ZONING (PH):

A public hearing to consider a proposed **Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2022**, amending Chapter 230, entitled 'ZONING', amending Section 230-17 C.(2)(e) to add new item [10] "OUTDOOR RECREATION- PARTICIPANT" and [11] "OUTDOOR RECREATION- SPECTATOR" with a Town Board Special Permit to said section of the Code of the Town of Clay.

Supervisor Ulatowski asked if anyone was present to speak on behalf of the applicant. Matt Vredenburgh and Andrew Cherock said that they were trying to establish a project that would be based on the approval of the local law passing. They explained that if the local law is passed they will submit an application for a recreation complex near NTTS on Buckley Road in the industrial zone. They continued that the advantage would be that there are no residential homes and the noise would not be an issue. They are considering outdoor baseball, kickball and basketball. If this local law is passed they will seek the **special permit** for this project. Councilor Young asked if this use will be allowed in all industrial zones. Commissioner Territo responded, only in I-1 and with a special permit. Councilor Hess said that he is in favor of this application. Councilor Bick added that this public hearing is only for the Local Law to change the zoning for I-1 to allow for recreational use and that it is a coincidence that the applicant is here. All questions and comments satisfied, Supervisor Ulatowski **closed** the public hearing.

Project/Water (PH) - OAK ORCHARD WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT EXTENSION NO. 1:

A public hearing to consider a Petition for the creation of a water supply district within the Town of Clay to be designated and known as "OAK ORCHARD WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT EXTENSION NO.1" was opened by the Supervisor.

Alex Wisnewski spoke on behalf of the applicant. He began by explaining that the property at 4776 Oak Orchard was recently subdivided into 2 parcels. The reason for this application is so that the applicant can get water service from OCWA for the property that he will build on. There were no further questions or comments and the Supervisor **closed** the public hearing.

<u>Project/Sewer (PH) - WILDCREEK SEWER DISTRICT EXTENSION,</u> <u>CONTRACT NO. 1:</u>

A public hearing to consider a Petition for the creation of a sewer district within the Town of Clay to be designated and known as "WILDCREEK SEWER DISTRICT EXTENSION" and for the construction and acquisition of a sewer system therein to be designated and known as "WILDCREEK SEWER DISTRICT EXTENSION, CONTRACT NO. 1." was opened by the Supervisor.

Alex Wisnewski was present on behalf of the applicants. He explained that 4961 and 4971 Buckley Road are currently served by septic and one of the two septic systems is failing. The third parcel has secured grant money to connect his property to sewer. Mr. Wisnewski said that he had met with the owner of the third parcel to see if he wished to be a part of this application. He explained that he had applied for and received a grant. Mr. Wisnewski continued that the two parcels involved will pay for the sewer connection which will occur between 7614 and 7616 Wild Turkey Way. There will be no cost to the Town of Clay.

Ron DeTota said that he had met with Mr. Wisnewski and applauded his proactive approach to talking to the property owners.

There being no additional questions or comments, Supervisor Ulatowski **closed** the public hearing.

Zone Change (PH/Adj.) – Town Board Case # 1173 FIRE DETECTION SYSTEMS, INC.:

A public hearing to consider the application of **FIRE DETECTION SYSTEMS**, **INC.**, for a Zone Change for **ALLEN ROAD**, **Tax Map No. 112.-07-11.5** from R-10 to O-1 to allow for a non-retail office on +/-1.53 acres of land (readvertised to this date and time on June 21, 2022, last heard at the May 2, 2022 meeting) was opened by the Supervisor; proof of publication and posting was furnished by the Town Clerk.
